Last month JC and I were grateful for the opportunity to travel to Botswana. We were deeply humbled by the passion to equip and train people that we found among the leaders and grateful to hear their appreciation for the AABS program which is a tool they can use to fulfill their passion. Joshua Tuffour, the manager at our head office in Ghana, also joined us. A highlight was attending a festive graduation ceremony for 120 students from some of the 18 AABS member Bible schools in Botswana. The guest speaker from Zimbabwe challenged them to preach God's truth in a world that so desperately needs it.
