- Through our partnership with the Hopewell Network and other relationships, God is providing opportunities for AABS to resource Bible schools outside Africa. Currently these countries are Mexico, Haiti, Costa Rica and India. We thank God for the privilege to serve churches, church leaders, and Bible schools around the globe.
- Because of this expansion, we are in the process of registering a new DBA name, “All-nations Association of Bible Schools.”
