### *Exciting Updates from the AABS West Africa Region*

The work of AABS continues to flourish across West Africa! Our teams in Nigeria, Ghana, Togo, Benin, and beyond are making tremendous progress in advancing Bible training and leadership development. Three major National Conferences were held across the region so far this year with great success:

● **AABS Nigeria** hosted its 4th National Conference on August 6–7. Delegates from across the country gathered for powerful teaching, worship, and fellowship. Though attendance was smaller than expected, the presence of the Holy Spirit was evident throughout. The event featured impactful sessions led by our Nigeria National Director, **Aps. A. C. Godfrey**, **Prof. Patricia Iroele**, and **Dr. Adim Paul**, with messages of encouragement sent from international partners.

● **AABS Ghana** held its National Conference September 2–5. Approximately 65 Bible School Directors and Pastors participated. Regional representatives were appointed for four regions to strengthen AABS's reach throughout Ghana—Volta, North East, Western, and Upper East.

● **AABS Togo-Benin** hosted a joint National Conference September 4–5 under the theme “*What to Do to Finish the Christian Race Well.*” With 160 attendees—

including Bible School Directors, pastors, and Christian leaders—the conference featured rich teaching, music, and fellowship. The final session, led by **Rev. James Odoom**, highlighted the mission of AABS and inspired many new participants to join.
