One of the greatest privileges of serving through All-nations Association of Bible Schools (AABS) is witnessing how God is raising up leaders in places where the need for Biblical training is greatest. This past November, our Executive Director, JC, had the opportunity to travel to Mozambique to meet with leaders of the Makua Project, an extraordinary movement of God among the Makua people.

The Makua Project represents a rapidly growing community of more than **120,000 Muslim-background believers** worshipping in **1,923 churches** across Mozambique. As the church continues to expand, one challenge has become increasingly clear: there is an urgent need for well-trained pastors and ministry leaders who can faithfully disciple believers and shepherd these growing congregations. During his visit, JC spent time with **Gerald Steele** and the Makua Project leadership team, discussing how AABS can partner with them to meet this critical need. Together, they are working toward establishing **four AABS -associated Bible schools** in strategic locations throughout Mozambique. These schools will provide accessible, practical, and biblically grounded leadership training for pastors and church leaders who are already serving on the front lines of ministry.
