AABS Partner Spotlight: Word of Life Bible College

AABS is grateful to share a praise-filled report from one of our associated member schools, **Word of Life Bible College**, whose growth and impact reflect God's faithfulness and the fruit of committed partnership in theological education.

The journey of Word of Life Bible College with AABS began in **2023**, when affiliation processes were successfully completed with the AABS office in Accra, with the dedicated support of **Rev. James Atta Odoom**. This marked an important foundation for what God would soon unfold through the college.



On **August 31, 2024**, Word of Life Bible College was officially inaugurated, and lectures commenced shortly thereafter on **September 14, 2024**. Over the course of one year, students diligently completed **forty-eight courses of the MOTMOT 1 program**, guided by **three committed lecturers**. By **September 14, 2025**, the college celebrated a major milestone as **five students graduated and were ordained as pastors**, stepping into ministry equipped with sound biblical training.

In **2025**, during a pastors' conference of the church, Word of Life Bible College was formally **adopted as the church's primary institution for training pastors**. This significant endorsement led to the launch of advanced training. Beginning **January 5, 2026**, senior pastors holding at least a diploma in theological studies began **MOTMOT 2 courses**, working toward an **advanced diploma in Biblical Studies**.



Today, the college's reach is truly international. The current MOTMOT 2 cohort includes **eleven students from Zambia, Sierra Leone, The Gambia, Liberia, and the United States**, studying together in a shared commitment to ministry excellence. This momentum is paving the way for an even larger **online MOTMOT 1 intake in April 2026**, open to students across member countries.

Another exciting development is the **launch of the French-language program in Cameroon**. With **three French-speaking lecturers**, classes began concurrently with those in Ghana. **Four senior pastors' students** are already enrolled, and preparations are underway for expanded MOTMOT 1 enrollment in April 2026.

Looking ahead, the long-term vision of Word of Life Bible College is to **establish branches in additional member countries**, following the model now underway in Cameroon. This expansion reflects a clear calling to raise biblically grounded leaders across nations.

We praise God for what He is doing through Word of Life Bible College and thank our AABS supporters for making partnerships like this possible. Please continue to pray for the faculty, students, and leadership as they train servants of Christ for effective ministry across Africa and beyond.
